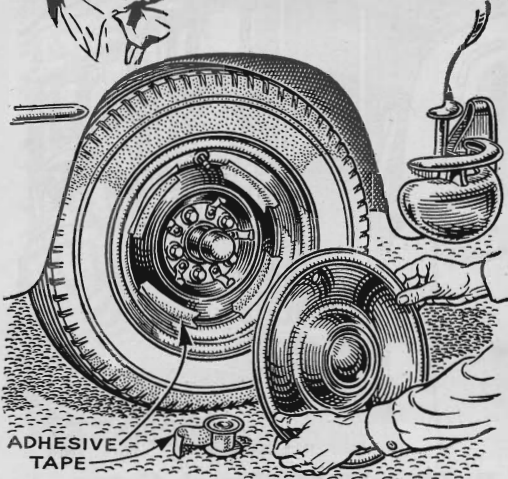




## Hints from the Model Garage

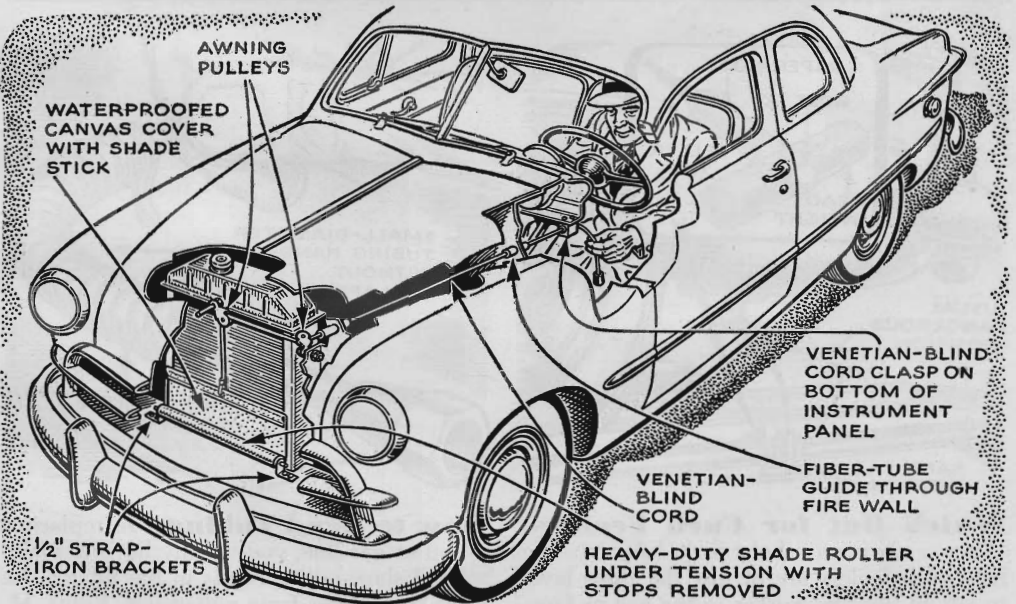


ADHESIVE TAPE

**Stones in Your Hub Caps?** On gravel roads, small stones can fly through the slots in the backs of the wheels and rattle around in the hub caps. To keep them out, Alvin G. Gunter, of Rockford, Ill., suggests putting tape over the slots.



**Drain Holes Save Muffler.** If your new muffler doesn't have drain holes, drill a couple of small ones in the places shown in the sketch. These will allow water and condensation to drain out, reducing the likelihood of the muffler rusting.



**Radiator Cover Warms Engine.** When the thermometer dips toward zero, an adjustable radiator cover will give your engine a nice boost. Donald Rich-

ards, of Brooklyn, N. Y., installed this one after finding he got little benefit from his hot-water heater on cold days. The cover can be adjusted while driving.
