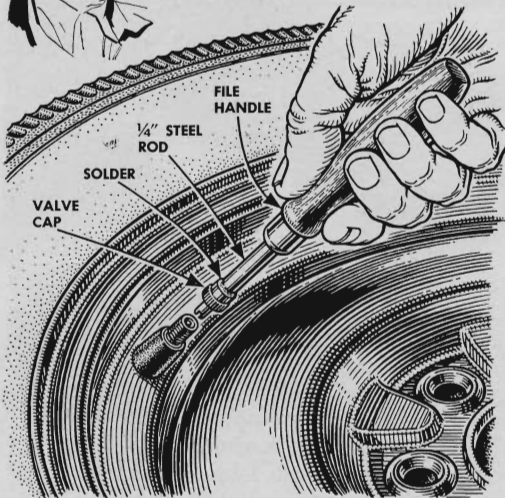




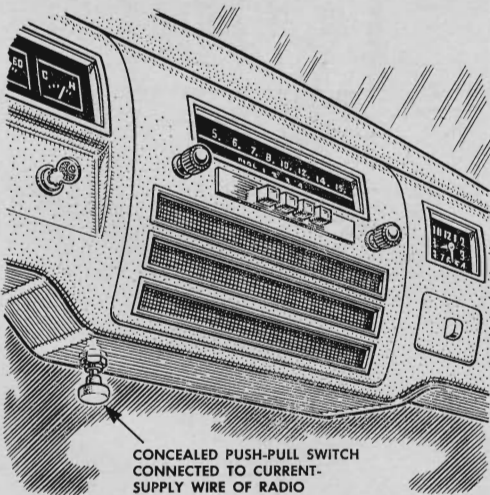
Hints FROM THE MODEL GARAGE



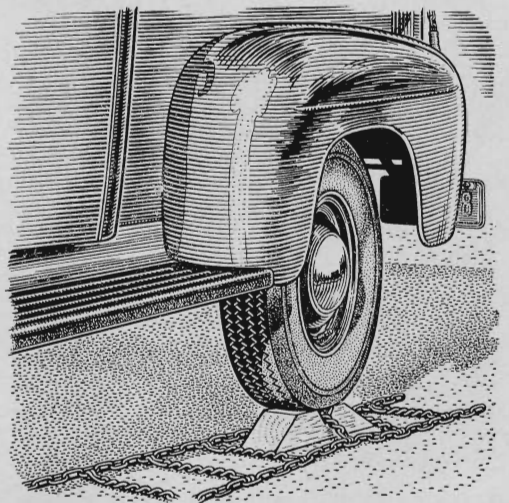
Valve cores can be quickly removed from tire tubes with this screwdriver-like tool. A valve cap—the kind with a core-extracting tip—is brazed or soldered to one end of a $\frac{1}{4}$ " steel rod and a wood file handle is forced on the other end.



An extra hand strap added to the right front seat will make it easier to get in and out, and provide a handhold on rough and curving roads. Securing the strap to one of the screws that hold the sunshade bracket saves drilling new holes.



A car radio can be turned on and off without disturbing the volume control if you wire a separate push-pull switch in ahead of the regular one on the control. Position of the knob under the dashboard also helps prevent unauthorized use.



Tire chains can be quickly put on without jacking up the car with this ramp made from a 4"-by-4" notched in the middle. One cross link is laid in the notch and the wheel driven on top, leaving the chains loose at the bottom and easy to clasp.
