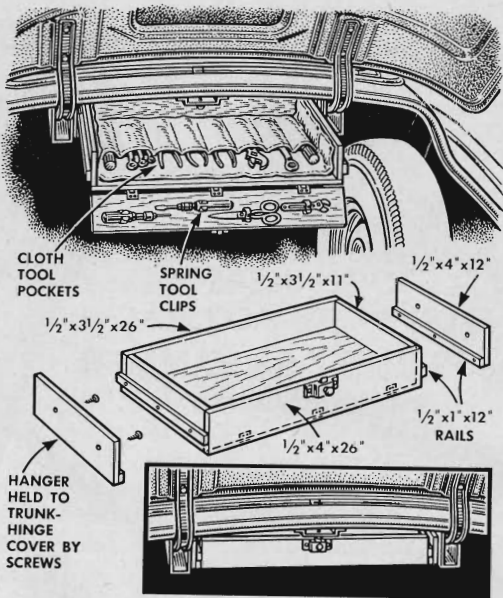


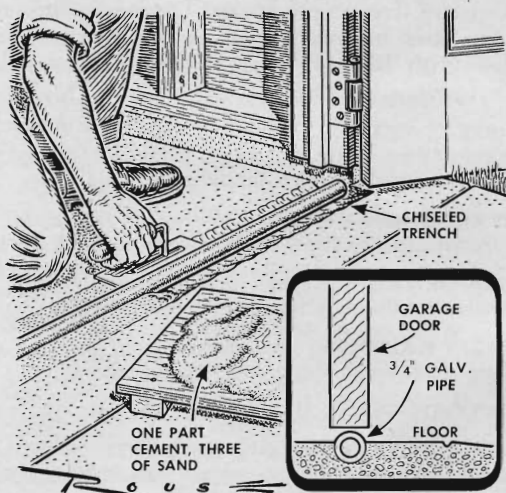
Don't blame the head gasket when traces of water or antifreeze appear on top of a cylinder head. Chances are that the fluid is seeping up along the threads of a head bolt. Stop the leak by removing the bolt and coating the threads and shank with white lead or gasket cement.



Tools won't rattle or be in the way if they're stowed in a space-saving drawer like this one built to fit between the rear-deck hinges. Fasten wood side rails to the hinge covers with self-tapping screws and fit a cupboard catch to the drawer front to keep it from sliding.



Put finishing touches on a polish job by cleaning up any mess made by the polish. Clean wax smears off windshield with glass cleaner for better vision at night. If polish is spilled on upholstery, allow it to dry then brush it out. If spot remains, rub lightly with soapsuds.



To keep rain, leaves and dirt from blowing under your garage door, install a length of galvanized pipe across the threshold. Chisel out a trench from jamb to jamb about half the diameter of the pipe, lay the pipe in place and trowel concrete flush with the floor on both sides.
