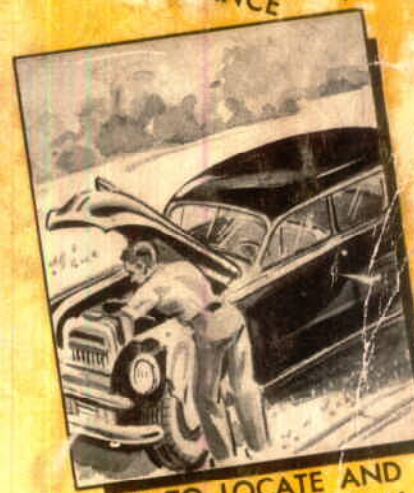

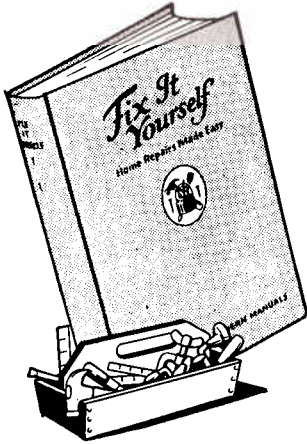

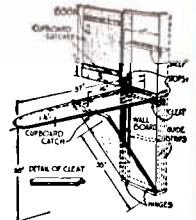


FIG. 22. When open, the lower door supports the ironing board.

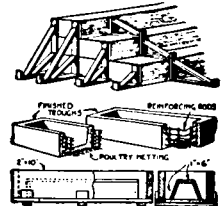


FIG. 4. How to make forms for steps and for water troughs.
