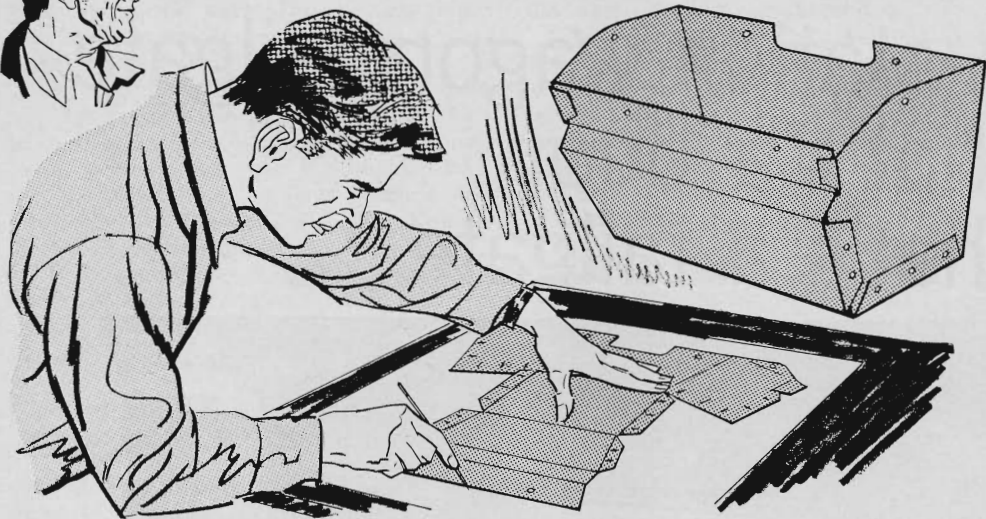


# Hints from the Model Garage



Even if your glove box has a lock, it is not burglarproof, as the box itself is made of cardboard. A metal box can easily be fabricated by using the cardboard as a pattern. Remove the box, take out the staples, place the cardboard flat on a piece

of light sheet metal, scribe the shape and mark the mounting holes. Next, cut the metal and drill the holes. Bend the metal into shape and fasten corners. Soldering should give sufficient strength. Bolt the new box in place, and lock it.



A loose insulation blanket under the hood can cause trouble. Fasten it with a thin rod across the front blanket edge, using a wire hook at each end. If the blanket is already damaged, protect the air-cleaner intake by adding a piece of screen wire.



A broken or cracked windshield washer line can be fixed by snipping off a piece of ball-point pen refill, inserting it into the broken line, joining the pieces and taping them. The refill is plastic, and a half-inch can be cut with no damage to the pen.
